.8	(b), the department shall not keep on the record of a driver any conviction for a violation
.9	of a speed limit of 55 or 60 miles per hour unless the violation consisted of a speed greater
.10	than ten miles per hour in excess of a 55 miles per hour the speed limit, or more than five
.11	miles per hour in excess of a 60 miles per hour speed limit.
.12	(b) This subdivision does not apply to (1) a violation that occurs in a commercial
.13	motor vehicle, or (2) a violation committed by a holder of a class A, B, or C commercial
