1.7	\$100,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the Metropolitan Council
1.8	for a grant to the city of Inver Grove Heights to design and renovate the west bank bridge
1.9	and bridge approach to Mississippi River Bridge 5600, commonly known as the Rock
1.10	Island Swing Bridge, located between Inver Grove Heights and St. Paul Park in Dakota
