1.6	Section 1. HOPKINS TAX INCREMENT FINANCING DISTRICTS.
1.7	Subdivision 1. District extension. The governing body of the city of Hopkins
1.8	may elect to extend the duration of its redevelopment tax increment financing districts
1.9	1-3 and 1-4 by up to five additional years.
1.10	Subd. 2. Five-year rule. The requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 469.1763,
1.11	subdivision 3, must be considered to be met for the city of Hopkins redevelopment tax
1.12	increment district 1-3, if the activities are undertaken within seven years from the date of
