1.6	Section 1. POTTER CENTER FOR THE ARTS, CHATFIELD.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$9,105,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.8	fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to
1.9	Independent School District No. 227, Chatfield, to predesign, design, renovate, construct
1.10	furnish, and equip the Potter Center for the Arts in the city of Chatfield. The center
1.11	includes the Potter Memorial Auditorium, space for the Chatfield Brass Band Free Music
1.12	Lending Library, gallery and museum space, a plaza, and a senior citizen and community
1.13	space. The school district may enter into lease and management agreements with the city
