1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to chiropractic; retaining the business of a deceased spouse; proposing  
1.3 coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 148.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. [148.110] CLINIC OPERATION.

1.6 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the surviving spouse of the owner of a  
1.7 chiropractic clinic shall be entitled to retain the deceased spouse's business interest in the  
1.8 chiropractic clinic for up to one year following the death of the spouse.
