1.7	Subd. 10. <b>Transmission line.</b> A high-voltage transmission line longer than one mile
1.8	with a capacity of 100 kilovolts or more that is located in a city of the first class in a
1.9	zone within one mile of the transmission line in which population density exceeds 8,000
1.10	persons per square mile, and that runs parallel to and is within one-quarter mile of a
1.11	below-grade bike and walking path that connects with other bike paths along a river, is
1.12	subject to the provisions of this section.
1.13	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment
1.14	and applies to all high-voltage transmission lines that have not received a routing permit
1.15	from the commission as of the effective date of this act.
