1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 13.47, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.7 Subdivision 1. **Definitions.** (a) "Employer data" means data on an employer's
1.8 operations, policies, and workforce related needs, and data on the recommendations
1.9 received by and the services provided to an employer by a provider of employment training
1.10 services, to address an employer's workforce related needs, which is collected, maintained,
1.11 used, or disseminated because an employer pays for services provided or applies for, is
1.12 currently enrolled in, or has been enrolled in employment and training programs under the
1.13 Workforce Investment Act of 1998, United States Code, title 29, section 2801.

1.14 (b) "Employment and training data" means data on individuals collected, maintained,
1.15 used, or disseminated because an individual or an individual's current or former employer
1.16 pays for services provided or applies for, is currently enrolled in, or has been enrolled in
1.17 employment and training programs funded with federal, state, or local resources, including
1.18 those provided under the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, United States Code, title 29,
1.19 section 2801.

1.20 ~~(b)~~ (c) "Employment and training service provider" means an entity certified, or
1.21 seeking to be certified, by the commissioner of employment and economic development to
1.22 deliver employment and training services under section 116J.401, subdivision 2, or an
1.23 organization that contracts with a certified entity or the Department of Employment and
1.24 Economic Development to deliver employment and training services.

2.2 training under the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, United States Code, title 29,
2.3 section 2801.

2.9 Subd. 3. **Dissemination.** Employer data and employment and training data may be

2.19 Subd. 4. **Data preparation.** To produce data required to certify the eligibility
2.20 of training service providers under the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, United
2.21 States Code, title 29, section 2801, or other studies required by law, the commissioner
2.22 of employment and economic development may enter into a data exchange agreement
2.23 with a training service provider whereby the commissioner of employment and economic
2.24 development shall furnish to the provider wage information under section 268.044 on
2.25 individuals or current or former employees of an employer who have received training
2.26 services from the provider. The provider shall use this wage information to prepare
2.27 summary data determined necessary by the commissioner. The provider may use this
2.28 wage information for conducting studies to improve instruction.
