1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. [197.792] FINANCIAL COUNSELING.
1.7	The commissioner shall make available financial counseling services to any veteran
1.8	of any branch or unit of the United States armed forces, upon the person's separation or
1.9	discharge from active military service and for up to 18 months following the person's
1.10	separation or discharge.
1.11	Counseling services are deemed to be available to a person if the person is eligible to
1.12	obtain those services in a reasonably accessible manner and without cost from qualified
1.13	financial planners who have volunteered to provide the services to veterans at no cost,
1.14	provided that the commissioner has made significant efforts to inform eligible veterans of
1.15	the availability of those services, including procedures for obtaining them.
1.16	"Veteran" has the meaning given in section 197.447.
