1.3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.4	Section 1. TRUNK HIGHWAY 47 STRIPING.
1.5	By July 1, 2009, the commissioner of transportation shall:
1.6	(1) stripe marked Trunk Highway 47 to have at least four lanes, excluding turn lanes
1.7	from the intersection with Bunker Lake Boulevard NW to the intersection with Alpine
1.8	Drive in the city of Ramsey;
1.9	(2) stripe a northbound right-hand turn lane from marked Trunk Highway 47 onto
1.10	Bunker Lake Boulevard NW in the city of Ramsey, so that the turn lane starts at the
1.11	intersection of marked Trunk Highway 47 and Coolidge Street; and
1.12	(3) eliminate the right-hand edge striping on northbound marked Trunk Highway
1.13	47 from the intersection with Pleasant Street to the intersection with Martin Street in
1.14	the city of Anoka.
1.15	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
