1.8	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$6,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9	fund to the Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities for Mesabi
1.10	Range Community and Technical College to design, construct, furnish, and equip an
1.11	addition to and remodeling of existing space for the Iron Range engineering program,
1.12	including laboratory spaces, other learning spaces, and improvements to the entrance, and
1.13	to acquire a privately owned housing facility on the campus.
