1.5	Section 1. CARLTON COUNTY COMMUNITY SERVICES BUILDING.
1.6	Subdivision 1. <b>Appropriation.</b> \$4,800,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.7	fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to
1.8	Carlton County to acquire land and to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a
1.9	county community services building of approximately 36,000 to 40,000 square feet, to
1.10	house the county health and human services, veterans services, Minnesota Workforce
1.11	Center, and motor vehicle licensing.
1.12	The appropriation is not available until the commissioner determines that at least an
1.13	equal amount has been committed to the project from nonstate sources.
1.14	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the
1.15	bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue
1.16	bonds of the state in an amount up to \$4,800,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with
1.17	the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the
