1.8	allowances specified in law for living and miscellaneous expenses, and an allowance
1.9	for tuition and fees equal to the lesser of the average tuition and fees charged by the
1.10	institution, or the tuition and fee maximums established in law.
1.11	(b) Except for students eligible under paragraph (c), for a student registering for
1.12	less than full time, the office shall prorate the cost of attendance to the actual number of
1.13	credits for which the student is enrolled.
1.14	(c) For a student registering for less than full time at an eligible public institution
1.15	who is eligible for a Pell grant and whose parents have had no postsecondary education,
