1.10 Unexpended funds appropriated in fiscal year 2010 for COBRA grants under Laws
1.11 2009, chapter 79, article 5, section 78, do not cancel and are available to the commissioner
1.12 of human services for fiscal year 2011 COBRA grant expenditures. Up to \$..... of the
