1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to farm wineries; allowing the holder of an intoxicating liquor license
1.3 to own and operate a farm winery; amending Minnesota Statutes 2008, section
1.4 340A.315, by adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 340A.315, is amended by adding a
1.7 subdivision to read:

1.8 Subd. 8. **Separate licensure allowed.** The holder of an on-sale or off-sale
1.9 intoxicating liquor license may operate a farm winery, as long as no products from the
1.10 farm winery are exclusively offered for sale or tasting at the site of the intoxicating
1.11 liquor license.
