1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 609.505, subdivision 1, is amended to read:
1.6	Subdivision 1. False reporting. Whoever informs a law enforcement officer that a
1.7	crime has been committed or otherwise provides information to an on-duty peace officer,
1.8	knowing that the person is a peace officer, regarding the conduct of others, knowing
1.9	that it is false and intending that the officer shall act in reliance upon it, is guilty of a
1.10	misdemeanor. A person who is convicted a second or subsequent time under this section
1.11	is guilty of a gross misdemeanor. crime and may be sentenced as follows:
1.12	(1) if the report is a false report of a misdemeanor, the person is guilty of a
1.13	misdemeanor;
1.14	(2) if the report is a false report of a gross misdemeanor, the person is guilty of a
1.15	gross misdemeanor; and
1.16	(3) if the report is a false report of a felony, the person is guilty of a felony and may
1.17	be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than five years or to payment of a fine of
1.18	not more than \$10,000, or both.
1.19	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective August 1, 2010, and applies to crimes
