1.9	resulting from the use of public safety equipment donated by the municipality. For
1.10	purposes of this subdivision, immunity extends to an employee, officer, or agent of a
1.11	municipality if the claim is based upon actions taken within the scope of the employee's,
1.12	officer's, or agent's duties.
1.13	(b) As used in this subdivision, "public safety equipment" means any equipment
1.14	purchased or obtained through gifts or grants by a municipality for use in responding to or
1.15	training for emergencies.
1.16	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective August 1, 2010, and applies to
