1.3 reinstatement diversion pilot program to be extended for 18 months; amending

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Laws 2009, chapter 59, article 3, section 4, subdivision 9, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 9. **Sunset.** ~~The pilot project under this section expires June 30, 2011.~~ A city
1.8 participating in this pilot program may accept an individual for diversion into the pilot
1.9 program until June 30, 2011. The third party administering the diversion program may
1.10 collect and disburse fees collected pursuant to subdivision 6, paragraph (a), clause (2),
1.11 through December 31, 2012, at which time the pilot program under this section expires.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
