1.5	Section 1. MOWER COUNTY PILOT PROJECT; FOUR-DAY WEEK FOR
1.6	COUNTY OFFICES.
1.7	Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 373.052, subdivision 1, the Mower
1.8	County Board of County Commissioners may provide by ordinance that county offices
1.9	are open for public business four business days a week, except (1) legal holidays, (2)
1.10	holidays established by the county board pursuant to contract with certified employee
1.11	bargaining units, and (3) emergency situations. "Business day" means Monday, Tuesday,
1.12	Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. The county must not adopt an ordinance establishing
