The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Environment Policy and Oversight

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state lands; authorizing private sale of certain tax-forfeited land.

1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **PRIVATE SALE OF TAX-FORFEITED LAND; ROSEAU COUNTY.**

1.5 (a) Notwithstanding the public sale provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 282,
1.6 or other law to the contrary, Roseau County may sell by private sale the tax-forfeited
1.7 land described in paragraph (c).

1.8 (b) The conveyance must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The attorney
1.9 general may make changes to the land description to correct errors and ensure accuracy.

1.10 (c) The land to be sold is located in Roseau County and is described as: the
1.11 Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast
1.12 Quarter, Section 20, Township 163, Range 36.

1.13 (d) The county has determined that the county's land management interests would
1.14 best be served if the lands were returned to private ownership.
