1.2 relating to the Board of Barber Examiners; modifying license fees; appropriating
1.3 money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2009 Supplement, sections 154.002;

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2009 Supplement, section 154.002, is amended to read:

1.7 **154.002 OFFICERS; COMPENSATION; FEES; EXPENSES.**

1.8 The Board of Barber Examiners shall annually elect a chair and secretary. It shall
1.9 adopt and use a common seal for the authentication of its orders and records. The board
1.10 shall appoint an executive secretary ~~who~~ or enter into an interagency agreement to procure
1.11 the services of an executive secretary. The executive secretary shall not be a member of
1.12 the board and ~~who~~ shall be in the unclassified civil service. The position of executive
1.13 secretary may be a part-time position.

1.14 The executive secretary shall keep a record of all proceedings of the board. The
1.15 expenses of administering this chapter shall be paid from the appropriations made to
1.16 the Board of Barber Examiners.

1.17 Each member of the board shall take the oath provided by law for public officers.

1.18 A majority of the board, in meeting assembled, may perform and exercise all the
1.19 duties and powers devolving upon the board.

1.20 The members of the board shall receive compensation for each day spent on board
1.21 activities, but not to exceed 20 days in any calendar month nor 100 days in any calendar
1.22 year.

1.23 The board shall have authority to employ such inspectors, clerks, deputies, and other
1.24 assistants as it may deem necessary to carry out the provisions of this chapter.

2.3 (a) The fees collected, as required in this chapter, chapter 214, and the rules of the
2.4 board, shall be paid to the ~~executive secretary of the board~~. The ~~executive secretary~~ board
2.5 shall deposit the fees in the general fund in the state treasury.

2.6 (b) The board shall charge the following fees:

2.7 (1) examination and certificate, registered barber, ~~\$65~~ \$85;

2.8 (2) examination and certificate, apprentice, ~~\$60~~ \$80;

2.9 (3) examination, instructor, ~~\$160~~ \$180;

2.10 (4) certificate, instructor, ~~\$45~~ \$65;

2.11 (5) temporary teacher or apprentice permit, ~~\$60~~ \$80;

2.12 (6) renewal of license, registered barber, ~~\$60~~ \$80;

2.13 (7) renewal of license, apprentice, ~~\$50~~ \$70;

2.14 (8) renewal of license, instructor, ~~\$60~~ \$80;

2.15 (9) renewal of temporary teacher permit, ~~\$45~~ \$65;

2.16 (10) student permit, ~~\$25~~ \$45;

2.17 (11) initial shop registration, ~~\$65~~ \$85;

2.18 (12) initial school registration, ~~\$1,010~~ \$1,030;

2.19 (13) renewal shop registration, ~~\$65~~ \$85;

2.20 (14) renewal school registration, ~~\$260~~ \$280;

2.21 (15) restoration of registered barber license, ~~\$75~~ \$95;

2.22 (16) restoration of apprentice license, ~~\$70~~ \$90;

2.23 (17) restoration of shop registration, ~~\$85~~ \$105;

2.24 (18) change of ownership or location, ~~\$35~~ \$55;

2.25 (19) duplicate license, ~~\$20~~ \$40;

2.26 (20) home study course, ~~\$75~~ \$95; and

2.27 (21) registration of hair braiders, ~~\$20~~ \$40 per year.
