1.2 relating to labor and industry; modifying licensing requirements for well  
1.3 contractors in certain cases; amending Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 326B.46,  
1.4 subdivision 6.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 326B.46, subdivision 6, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 6. **Well contractor exempt from licensing and bond; conditions.** No  
1.8 license, registration, or bond under sections 326B.42 to 326B.49 is required of a well  
1.9 contractor or a limited well/boring contractor who is licensed and bonded under section  
1.10 103I.525 or 103I.531 and is engaged in the work or business of installing  
1.11 (1) water service pipe from a well to a pressure tank ~~or;~~  
1.12 (2) a frost-free water hydrant with an antisiphon device ~~which is~~ on a well water  
1.13 service pipe located entirely outside of a structure building requiring potable water, ~~or;~~  
1.14 ~~(2) (3) a temporary shut-off control valve, located outside the building, on a well~~  
1.15 ~~water service pipe. For the purposes of this subdivision, "temporary" means a time period~~  
1.16 ~~not to exceed six months. This subdivision expires May 14, 2011.; or~~  
1.17 (4) a main control valve located within two feet of the pressure tank on the  
1.18 distribution supply line.
