The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Regulatory Reform

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to insurance; modifying defensive driving refresher course requirements;  
1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 65B.28, subdivision 4.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2010, section 65B.28, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 4. **Completion certificate.** ~~Persons~~ A person 55 years old and older may  
1.7 retake the original course or take the refresher course every three years and receive a  
1.8 course completion certificate to remain eligible for the premium reduction in subdivision  
1.9 1. A person 55 years old and older who successfully completes a retaking of the original  
1.10 course or a refresher course more than three years from the date the person last was  
1.11 eligible for the premium reduction in subdivision 1 is entitled to reinstatement of this  
1.12 eligibility. The Department of Public Safety shall provide criteria for the issuance of  
1.13 the course completion certificates.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION.** This section is effective the day following  
1.15 final enactment and applies to a person who successfully completes the retake of the  
1.16 original course or the four-hour refresher course established pursuant to this section,  
1.17 on or after that date.
