1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to education; requiring schools to maintain a supply of opiate antagonists;
1.3 proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 121A.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. [121A.224] OPIATE ANTAGONISTS.

1.6 (a) A school district or charter school must maintain a supply of opiate antagonists, as
1.7 defined in section 604A.04, subdivision 1, at each school site to be administered in
1.8 compliance with section 151.37, subdivision 12.

1.9 (b) A school district or charter school may enter into arrangements with suppliers of
1.10 opiate antagonists to obtain opiate antagonists at fair market, free, or reduced prices. A third
1.11 party, other than a supplier, may pay for a school's supply of opiate antagonists.

1.12 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective July 1, 2022.
