1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 290.0122, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 5. Interest. A taxpayer is allowed a deduction for interest. The deduction equals
1.8 the amount allowed to the taxpayer as interest paid or accrued during the taxable year under
1.9 section 163 of the Internal Revenue Code with the following exceptions: excluding qualified
1.10 residence interest, as defined in section 163(h)(3).

1.11 ~~(1) qualified residence interest excludes home equity interest;~~

1.12 ~~(2) acquisition indebtedness must not exceed \$750,000, or \$375,000 for a married~~
1.13 ~~separate return, for indebtedness incurred on or after December 16, 2017; and~~

1.14 ~~(3) mortgage insurance premiums treated as interest under section 163(h)(3)(E) are not~~
1.15 ~~interest for the purposes of this subdivision.~~

1.16 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective for taxable years beginning after December
1.17 31, 2020.
