Committee Recommendation and Adoption of Report:

To Pass as Amended and re-referred to the Committee on Commerce and Labor

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to crimes; modifying the ticket scalping law; amending Minnesota
1.3 Statutes 2006, section 609.805, subdivision 2.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 609.805, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 2. **Acts constituting.** Whoever intentionally does any of the following is
1.7 guilty of a misdemeanor:

1.8 ~~(1) issues or sells tickets to an event without printing thereon in a conspicuous place~~
1.9 ~~the price of the ticket and the seat number, if any; or~~

1.10 ~~(2) (1) charges for admission to an event a price greater than that advertised or~~
1.11 ~~stated on tickets issued for the event; or~~

1.12 ~~(3) sells or offers to sell a ticket to an event at a price greater than that charged at the~~
1.13 ~~place of admission or printed on the ticket; or~~

1.14 ~~(4) (2) having received a ticket to an event under conditions restricting its transfer,~~
1.15 ~~sells it in violation of such conditions; or.~~

1.16 ~~(5) being in control of premises on or in which an event is conducted, permits the~~
1.17 ~~sale or exhibition for sale on or in such premises of a ticket to the event at a price greater~~
1.18 ~~than printed thereon.~~

1.19 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2007, and applies to acts
1.20 committed on or after that date.
