Read Second Time

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to local government; authorizing the city of Minneapolis to adopt an
1.3 ordinance to define the annual duration of operation of mobile food units.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **MINNEAPOLIS; MOBILE FOOD UNITS.**

1.6 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 157.15, subdivision 9, the city of
1.7 Minneapolis may by ordinance restrict the operation of permitted mobile food units to
1.8 a maximum annual number of days at any one place. The ordinance must include any
1.9 requirements or limitations the city considers reasonably necessary to protect the health,
1.10 safety, and general welfare of the public.

1.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment
1.12 without local approval as provided by Minnesota Statutes, section 645.023, subdivision 1,
1.13 paragraph (a).
