Committee Recommendation and Adoption of Report:

To Pass and re-referred to the Committee on Health and Human Services Finance

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to health care; prohibiting the expenditure of state funds to comply with
1.3 certain federal health care laws.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **PROHIBITION OF STATE FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT CERTAIN**
1.6 **FEDERAL HEALTH CARE REFORMS.**

1.7 State funds must not be expended in the planning or implementation of the Patient
1.8 Protection and Affordable Care Act, Public Law 111-148, as amended by the Health Care
1.9 and Education Affordability and Reconciliation Act of 2010, Public Law 111-152, and no
1.10 provisions of the act may be implemented, until the constitutionality of the act has been
1.11 affirmed by the United States Supreme Court.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
