The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Government Operations and Elections

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; permitting the Department of Administration to
1.3 contract for waste-hauling without determining whether state employees are able
1.4 to do the work; prohibiting the state from purchasing waste-hauling vehicles
1.5 for use in the Capitol complex; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
1.6 Statutes, chapter 16C.

1.7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.8 Section 1. 16C.0851 **WAIVER; WASTE CONTRACTS; VEHICLE**
1.9 **ACQUISITION PROHIBITED.**

1.10 Subdivision 1. **Waiver.** Notwithstanding section 16C.08, 16C.09, 43A.047, or other
1.11 law to the contrary, the commissioner may enter into or approve a service contract for
1.12 waste removal without determining that no current state employee is able and available to
1.13 perform the services called for by the contract.

1.14 Subd. 2. **Capitol complex.** The commissioner may not acquire by purchase or lease
1.15 a waste-hauling vehicle for use in the Capitol complex.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
