1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to liquor; authorizing a license for St. Cloud State University.

1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **ST. CLOUD STATE UNIVERSITY; ON-SALE LICENSE.**

1.5 Notwithstanding any other law, local ordinance, or charter provision to the contrary,
1.6 the city of St. Cloud may issue an on-sale wine and malt liquor intoxicating liquor license
1.7 to St. Cloud State University. A license authorized by this section may be issued for space
1.8 that is not compact and contiguous, provided that all the space is within the boundaries of
1.9 the campus of St. Cloud State University and is included in the description of the licensed
1.10 premises on the approved license application. The license under this section authorizes
1.11 sales on all days of the week to persons attending events at Herb Brooks National Hockey
1.12 Center, subject to the hours and days of sale restrictions in Minnesota Statutes, section
1.13 340A.504, and any reasonable license conditions or restrictions imposed by the licensing
1.14 authority. All other provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, not inconsistent with
1.15 this section, apply to the license authorized under this section.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective upon approval by the St. Cloud City
1.17 Council in the manner provided by Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021, subdivisions
1.18 2 and 3.
