1.8 Subd. 6. Access to data. Data created, collected, and maintained by the commissioner

1.9 for a business to receive and retain a certificate of compliance under this section is private

1.10 data or nonpublic data. Applications, forms, or similar documents submitted by a business

1.11 seeking a certificate of compliance is public data. A letter that states the commissioner's

1.12 decision to issue, not issue, revoke, or suspend a certificate of compliance is public data.
